The Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP)

This is a federally funded program to help qualifying low-income Iowa homeowners and renters pay for a portion of their primary heating costs for the winter heating season. The assistance is based on household income, household size, type of fuel, and type of housing. Applications are accepted on a first come first serve basis at your local community action agency. Elderly (60 and over) and/or disabled can apply between October 1st and April 15th. All other households can apply from November 1st through April 15th, Monday through Friday, or as posted at your local community action agency office.
