ANNUAL MEETING OF BOARD OF DIRECTORS
AUGUST 1, 2022

The Annual Meeting of the Board of Directors of Chariton Valley Electric Cooperative, Inc. was held at the King Opera House, 115 Benton Avenue, E. in Albia, Iowa, at 7:00 P.M. on the 1st day of August, 2022, pursuant to waiver of notice of all of the directors.

The meeting was called to order by Michael Miller, who served as Chairman of the meeting and Secretary Norman Major served as Secretary of the Meeting and kept the minutes thereof.

The Secretary then called the roll and reported that the following directors, including those elected at the Annual Meeting of the Members, were present:

said persons being all of the directors. Also present were Leilani Todd, General Manager/CEO, and Attorney Dennis L. Puckett.

All Directors waived notice of the meeting, and the Waiver is attached hereto.

The Chairman thereupon declared the meeting duly organized for the transaction of business and the election of officers.

The Chairman then stated that the next order of business would be the election of officers to hold office until the first meeting of the Board of Directors following the adjournment of the next Annual Meeting of the Members, and until their respective successors shall have been elected and shall have qualified.

The Chairman then turned to Attorney Puckett to conduct the election of officers.

Nominating ballots for the office of President were then distributed and completed by each of the directors. The ballots were collected and counted. The results of such nominating ballot for the office of President were reported as follows:

Randy Gottschalk	4 Nominating Ballots
Mike Miller	4 Nominating Ballots
John Houser	1 Nominating Ballot

Since there was not a majority on the nominating ballot, an election was held between Randy Gottschalk and Mike Miller. Mike Miller received 5 votes and Randy Gottschalk received 4 votes.

Mike Miller was thereupon declared to have been duly elected to the office of President to serve for a term of one year and until his successor shall have been duly elected and qualified.

Nominating ballots for the office of Vice President were then distributed and completed by each of the directors. The ballots were collected and counted. The results of such nominating ballot for the office of Vice President were reported as follows:

Marchelle Brown	1 Nominating Ballot

Finding an absolute majority on the nominating ballot, a motion was made, seconded and carried to have the nominating ballot serve as an election ballot. Randy Gottschalk was thereupon declared to have been duly elected to the office of Vice President to serve for a term of one year and until his successor shall have been duly elected and qualified.

Nominating ballots for the office of Secretary were then distributed and completed by each of the directors. The ballots were collected and counted. The results of such nominating ballot for the office of Secretary were reported as follows:

Norm Major	4 Nominating Ballots
Richard Welsh	2 Nominating Ballots
Kenny VandenBerg	3 Nominating Ballots

Since there was not a majority on the nominating ballot, an election was held between Norm Major and Kenny VandenBerg. Norm Major received 7 votes and Kenny VandenBerg received 2 votes. Norm Major was thereupon declared to have been duly elected to the office of Secretary, to serve for a term of one year and until his successor shall have been duly elected and qualified.

Nominating ballots for the office of Treasurer were then distributed and completed by each of the directors. The ballots were collected and counted. The results of such nominating ballot for the office of Treasurer were reported as follows:

Jerry Durian	1 Nominating Ballot

Finding an absolute majority on the nominating ballot, a motion was made, seconded and carried to have the nominating ballot serve as an election ballot. Marchelle Brown was thereupon declared to have been duly elected to the office of Treasurer to serve for a term of one year and until her successor shall have been duly elected and qualified.

There being no further business to come before the meeting, upon motion duly made, seconded and unanimously carried, the meeting adjourned.
