The 75th Annual Meeting of the Members of Chariton Valley Electric Cooperative, Inc. was held at the King Opera House, 115 Benton Avenue, E. in Albia, Iowa, at 6:30 P.M. on the 1st day of August, 2022.

The meeting was called to order by Michael Miller, President of the Cooperative, who presided. Secretary Norman Major acted as Secretary of the meeting and kept the minutes thereof.
